

Stephanie McGrath of SSMDesign is a local artist handcrafting beautiful ecofriendly heirloom fine jewelry inspired by nature. Most recently, she taught herself the ancient art of micro mosaics created with glass from its birthplace, Venice, Italy. You can often see Stephanie sitting in the window of Nest working on her next piece.

Kiera Light incorporates plant fibers from all over the world into her luminous paintings with which she deeply shares a human connection. Many of her unique pieces are on display and can be purchased at Nest.
